and then upon being presented with an Affidavit in Proof of Publication, and no one being present to protest the vacation of the easement, it was moved by Mr. Heck to allow the vacation of easement. It was seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

The Board agreed to the removal of an existing elm tree, but requested that the maple tree not be disturbed.
