## June 12, 1970

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board being present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of June 10, 1970.

Mr. Ice seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Receipt of the rent from Valleyview Rest Home for the month of June.

The Board received a copy of a tax protest statement filed in behalf of the Alpha Kappa Lambda Building Association protesting the second half of the 1969 real property and personal property tax.

The Board received notice from the City of Lawrence concerning a condemnation for Phase 3 of the Lawrence City project known as the Mud Creek Section and the request from the city for the Board of County Commissioners to proceed with the development of plans for the Jenney Klurnips two new bridges required to be constructed on Douglas County township roads. Mr. Heck such, Conse Enges moved we request from the firm of Finney & Turnipseed, Consulting Engineers of Topeka, Kansas, to present us with a proposal for design of two bridges which we have agreed to construct in connection with the Corps of Army Engineers proposed Mud Creek Levy project.

Refund real estate Tay Quane Schoake

The Board reviewed the request of Mr. Duane Schaake of R. 2 for a refund of real estate taxes paid for a period of five years on an 11 acre tract in Section 32-12-20, Douglas County Kansas, County Clerk's Plate #W-588. In view of an opinion issued by the County Attorney as of June 9, 1970, referring to K.S.A. 79-1701a which statute allows for a refund if the tax computed and paid was based on an erroneous assessment due to a clerical error which resulted in an overpayment of taxes by the taxpayer. The following motion was made: Mr. Heck moved that in view of the above opinion of the County Attorney that a County Commissioners Cancellation Order be authorized which will reimburse Mr. Duane Schaake for two years taxes on the property in question, which would refer to Plate #W-588. Mr. Ice seconded and motion carried unanimously.

Camm. Order# 753 County Commissioners Cancellation Order #753 was approved and signed by the Chairman and is on file in the office of the County Clerk.
