*Request to vacate denied*

to vacate the West 205 ft. of road #688-C, a road lying on the South line of a tract of ground described as Nieder Acres. After consideration and discussion, it was moved by Mr. Heck that the request to vacate the road be denied. Motion was seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

*Board of Tax Appeals Exemption*

Board acknowledged receipt of a notice from the State Board of Tax Appeals exempting from taxation the recently acquired lots on Rhode Island Street owned by Douglas County, to be used as a building site for the proposed new Judicial Building.

*Valleyview Home purchase beds etc.*

The Board authorized the purchase of 4 new hospital type beds for use at Valleyview Rest Home, complete with mattresses, and 10 replacement mattresses for use at Valleyview, for a total contract price of \$1,453.00 from the Goetze-Niemer Company, 1701 Brooklyn, Kansas City, Missouri. Mr. Ice moved we accept the bid. Seconded by Mr. Heck and carried unanimously.

*Bartlett & West, Cons. Engrs. Payment*

Mr. Heck moved we authorize the payment to Bartlett & West, Consulting Engineers, in the amount of \$6,239.50 for the Douglas County Comprehensive Water and Sewerage Study which has been completed. Of this amount, \$6,000.00 will be paid from funds available by a grant from Farmers Home Administration; the balance of \$239.50 by funds from Douglas County. Motion was seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

Mr. Ice moved the Board accept the bid of \$220.00 of Marvin Selichnow to remove the two dead trees at the 4-H Fairgrounds by August 5, 1970. Seconded by Mr. Heck and motion carried.

*Employ Candace Smith*

Mr. Ice moved the Board authorize the employment of Candace Smith as a Clerk in the office of the Probate Court, at a salary of \$285.00 per month beginning August 1, 1970. Seconded by Mr. Heck and motion carried.

*Resurface L. & L. road*

The condition of the Lone Star Lake road was discussed with the County Engineer, with particular reference to the approximately .8 mile of roadway which was recently scarified. Mr. Rice was instructed to re-surface this section of road as soon as possible, and apply a primer and one seal coat.

*La. St. Floodway Discussion*

Mr. Orman Snyder and Mr. Carter Anderson appeared before the Board to discuss further problems in connection with the Louisiana Street Floodway, and referred to the meeting which is scheduled for Wednesday, July 22, 1970.

*Items for correction 4-H Bldg.*

Mr. Fred Purvis, Co. Maintenance Supt., brought to the attention of the Board several items which he felt were not complete at the new 4-H Fairground Building. The items will be referred to the contractor for correction.
