3. All entrance of equipment onto the site shall be on existing driveways, no equipment shall be operated on the exterior lot sidewalks which are to remain in serviceable condition.

Election count of Nov. 3

The matter of the November 3, 1970, election count, pertaining to the 7th Precinct, 3rd Ward, City of Lawrence, was considered by the Board. Board was advised to proceed under K.S.A. 25-3107 as amended by the 1970 Session Laws.

Election Board recount ballots

In furtherance of the above referenced statute it was moved by Mr. Heck that the County election officer cause the election Board of the 7th Precinct, 3rd Ward to reconvene under his supervision and to recount the ballots with respect to the offices of Congressman, Third District, Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General and State Representative 40th District, because of an obvious error in the total count.

Conducted on Nov. 10th

Such recount to be conducted on November 10, 1970, and the results of the recount to be presented to the County Board of Canvassers at their regular meeting on Friday, November 13, 1970. Motion seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

Co. policy re. additions discussed

Board met with Darwin Rogers, County Assessor, to review existing County policy pertaining to reporting of additions and improvements being done in the unincorporated areas of Douglas County. Board to study problem and advise.

Employ: Wayne Kellum Zoning Adm.

Board met with applicant for position of Douglas County Zoning Administrator. The Board discussed the various duties and salary of the position with Mr. Wayne Kellum of LeCompton, Kansas. After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Ice that Mr. Kellum be hired as Douglas County Zoning Administrator, effective December 1, 1970, at a monthly salary of \$615.00 per month. Seconded by Mr. Heck, carried unanimously.

Install stop sign at G intersection

Board met with the County Engineer and discussed road and highway problems. Engineer was advised to install a stop sign at the 'T' intersection of the Drag Strip road and the extension of West 23rd Street. Also, instructed the County Engineer to discuss with the State Highway Resident Engineer the possibility of installing highway marking signs on the Middle Road prior to final acceptance by the State of Kansas.
