Sanderson appeared before the Board with Mr. Van Doren of our 31st Street Consultant firm, along with Mr. Galluzzi and Mr. Cady of Haskell Institute, and Mr. Seyler of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, from Anadarko, Okla. The meeting with our Commission was in reference to the various details relative to our acquiring right- of-way through Haskell lands for the 31st Street construction. Mr. Seyler indicated that they could furnish Douglas County with our required rights-of-way easements, but requested the following considerations: 1. That in our acquiring of right-of-way easements we take easement to all the Haskell land lying south of the sectionline, amounting to approximately 16 Acres over and above our immediate right-of-way. 2. That our north right-of-way line be

fenced according to Haskell's specifications, namely 5 barbed wires on steel posts, one rod apart. 3. That we construct at the Barker intersection at the north turnout to Haskell's property line, and that we treat the surface of the turnout in the same manner as the 31st Street surface. At the conclusion of the meeting Engr. Rice was requested to prepare the proper forms for acquiring this right-of-way easement, and upon such preparation we would present the request to Mr. Galluzzi, Superintendent of Haskell Institute.

Mrs. Reynolds Mrs. S. R. Reynolds of the Wakarusa Drainage Board, appeared before the Board to discuss ne for o-various drainage problems, largely in connection with the proposed ditch running east along Armstrong Road to the present Louisiana Floodway construction. The Board reiterated to Mrs. Reynolds our Agreement to provide necessary structures through the Township road and to carr the water flow-way into the Louisiana Floodway Ditch. The Board further reiterated their position that it would not be our responsibility to install or operate any flow control mechanism in this connection.
