Legal notice publication re. J.A.S. Rt 208

Letter re

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Board noted receipt of communication from the State Highway Commission of Kansas, that a legal notice is being published notifying the residents of Douglas County and all interested persons that Douglas County is requesting approval from the State Highway Commission of the design features on F.A.S. Route 208. The notice which will be first published in the Lawrence Journal World on July 22, 1971, will notify all interested persons that maps, drawings and all other information relative to the proposed design of F.A.S. Route 208 will be available for public inspection at the Douglas County Engineer's office.



Parsuant to Resolution #71-11, adopted July 2, 1971, the Board of Commissioners serving as a road viewing Board, accompanied by a similar Board representing the City of Lawrence, and Brands Ma by the Douglas County Engineer and Douglas County Counselor, did meet on July 16th, at the site of the proposed road relocation referred to as 31st Street from Louisiana St. to Haskell Avenue, or also referred to as road #699.
