Use Permit
Granted for
use of salvage
yard

Douglas County-City of Lawrence, Planner McClanathan and Zoning Administrator, Kellum appeared before the Board relative to a hearing listed as Item 4 of the minutes of March 29, Douglas County Planning Commission. This item is referred to as CUP-11-13-71 which is a request for a conditional use permit allowing for the operation of the use of a salvage yard generally located at intersection of County Roads 1061 and 458 in Eudora township. The application is submitted by Mr. L. L. Kindred. After due discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan and seconded by Mr. Ice that this permit be granted on the area described as follows:

Beginning at a point 430' North of the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 13 South, Range 21 East, in Douglas County, Kansas; thence North to the North line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence East 330' to the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence South on the East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ to the point of beginning. Contains 6.74 acres more or less.

The permit is granted subject to screening as provided by State Statute K.S.A. 68-2204, and that the salvage materials not be stacked to a height exceeding 8 feet. Motion carried unanimously.
