

April 17, 1972

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of April 13, 1972.

Proposal accepted from N. R. Hamm for seal coating county roads & to furnish chip spreader

Engineer Sanderson presented the Board a proposal from the firm of N. R. Hamm Contractor, Inc. to supply materials and equipment for seal coating county roads during the 1972 season. The proposal sets out a per gallon cost of \$0.21 for furnishing and applying all types and grades of liquid asphalt to any road in Douglas County. The proposal further sets out a unit price per ton of \$0.73 to furnish a self-propelled chip spreader, fully maintained and operated, for spreading cover material. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Cragan that the proposal as submitted by N. R. Hamm Contractor, Inc. be accepted. Motion carried unanimously.

Proposal accepted to control noxious weeds on state highway right-of-way

Herschel Hemphill, Douglas County Weed Supervisor, presented the Board a proposal which he will present to the State Highway Department for the control of noxious weeds on state highway right-of-way. It was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Cragan that the proposal as presented be approved. Motion carried unanimously.

Proposal accepted to continue Workmen's Comp. with Iowa Mutual Ins. Co.

Mr. Delbert Richardson, representing Iowa Mutual Insurance Company, appeared before the Board with proposal to continue Workmen's Compensation Insurance for Douglas County Engineering Department including all other employees with the sheriff, deputies, and park employees being insured on a separate policy. After due discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan and seconded by Mr. Ice that the proposal be accepted. Motion carried unanimously.
