The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 990. Order is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board received a request from Judge Charles Rankin for Board approval to employ Mrs. Barbara Copple on a full time basis effective May 1, 1972. Mrs. Copple has been working on a part time basis since November 1971. Judge Rankin requested a salary of \$360 per month. It was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Cragan that this request be granted with the understanding that this salary figure reflects a six month length of service increase. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board received a written report of a jail inspection made for the February 1972 term of district court. The report is submitted by Frank R.
