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Sheriff Johnson and Engineer Sanderson appeared before the Board accompanied by Ward Thompson, Jr. and Ward Thompson, Sr. representing Lawrence Communications, Inc. The purpose of their appearance was to discuss a proposed maintenance contract for all radio equipment owned by Douglas County. After considerable discussion it was agreed by Sheriff Johnson, Engineer Sanderson, and the Board that a contract for these services would not be entered into at this time, but that the repair and maintenance of all radio equipment would be directed to Lawrence Communications to be serviced on a time and material basis.
