This resolution relates to the providing of minimum construction standards for local roads and streets and other public improvements in subdivisions, other than commercial and industrial developments, herein referred to as residential subdivision, in Douglas County, Kansas. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that Resolution No. 72-30 be hereby adopted, seconded by Mr. Ice, and carried unanimously.

Engineer Sanderson then presented to the Board prepared Resolution No. 72-31. This resolution refers to the providing of minimum construction standards for collector roads and streets and other public improvements in subdivisions, other than industrial and commercial developments, hereinafter referred to as residential subdivisions, in Douglas County, Kansas. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Ice that Resolution No. 72-31 be hereby adopted, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

This resolution relates to establishing policy regarding bonding procedures for guarantee of construction of roads and streets and other public improvements and pinning of lots in subdivisions and developments in Douglas County, Kansas. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that Resolution No. 72-32 be hereby adopted, seconded by Mr. Ice, and carried unanimously.
