Pursuant to official notice the Board received and opened bids at 10:00 a.m. on the specified three categories of work and installation relative to the developing of the second district court facility in the Watkins Building. Three bids were received in the category of carpentry, painting, wood finishing, etc. The apparent low bidder being B. A. Green Construction Company with a base bid of \$10,000 and an alternate of \$710. On the bid item of furniture two bids were received with the apparent low bidder being M & M Office Supply with a base bid of \$9,428. On the item of carpets, draperies and blinds only one bid was received, that being the bid of Jennings Carpets and Draperies with a base bid of \$1,774. It should be noted that the Board requested other firms to bids on these items but no others were received. As required by the Governor's Committee on Criminal Administration, these bids will be forwarded to that office for their consideration and approval.
