County Clerk Mathia and Mr. Steven Weston, representing the Xerox Corporation, appeared before the Board to discuss the replacement of the presently rented No. 720 Xerox copier machine with a No. 4000 Xerox copier machine. Mr. Weston explained that the No. 4000 machine would have a much more decrease in noise level, a considerable higher output speed, and contained several improved operating features. He further indicated that the actual rental cost of the No. 4000 copier machine would be \$50 per month increase but that the lower per copy cost would make our net cost per month \$38 to \$40. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Heck that we accept the proposal of the Xerox Corporation to replace our present No. 700 rental machine with a newer model No. 4000, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
