The hearing relative to Item No. 11 of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission minutes of March 28, 1973, was convened in the District Courtroom in order to accommodate the number of persons attending the hearing. Mr. Dick McClanathan, Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Director, presented Item No. 11 which was a request by J H & J Rock Company, Inc., on property owned by Elmer Zeeb, for a conditional use permit to allow the operation of a rock quarry, generally located upon a 329 acre tract along the east and west sides of Douglas County Road No. 1025 three-fourths mile south of U.S. Highway 40. Mr. Ralph King, attorney for the neighboring landowners opposing the rock quarry permit request, made his presentation to the Board pertaining to the opinions of the landowners in opposition to the conditional use permit for the rock quarry. Mr. Jack Hurlburt, General Manager of J H & J Rock Company, made his plea in favor of the permit request to the Board. The Board at this time felt they needed additional time to make a thorough study of this existing situation before rendering a decision. After due discussion it was moved by Mr. Heck to continue this matter until Wednesday, April 18, at 11:00 a.m., seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
