County Counselor Dan Young appeared before the Board with Resolution No. 73-21 relating to mill levy for the operation of ambulance service in Douglas County.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that for the purpose of providing ambulance service in Douglas County, Kansas, under the authority of K.S.A. 1972 Supp. 19-261 and K.S.A. 1972 Supp. 19-262, a tax levy be made in an amount not in excess of one mill on each dollar of assessed valuation upon all taxable, tangible property in Douglas County, Kansas, it being the intention of said Board to levy .25 mill for the year 1974 for ambulance service.

It was moved by Mr. Heck that Resolution No. 73-21 be adopted, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
