These bids shall be in writing, signed by an authorized representa- tive of the bidding firm, and will remain on file in the Commission Office. Final decision on allowances of purchase and acceptance of any bid shall rest with the Board of Commissioners,
		3. County officers and department heads will continue to purchase ex- pendible supplies and items with a value of less than \$100 for use in their offices.
