The Board gave further consideration to the need for restating and clarifying purchasing policy which the Board will expect to be followed by county officers and department heads. Following such discussion it was moved by Mr. Heck that the following policy be adopted:

1. The office of county clerk will continue to purchase those supplies which are used compatibly by all or most offices. These purchases will be made on a basis determined to be fair and competitive by the office of the county clerk.
2. Officers and department heads desiring purchase of furniture or office equipment with value exceeding \$100 shall present to the Board two or more competitive bids for the supplying of the desired equipment. These bids shall be in writing, signed by an authorized representative of the bidding firm, and will remain on file in the Commission Office. Final decision on allowances of purchase and acceptance of any bid shall rest with the Board of Commissioners,
3. County officers and department heads will continue to purchase expendible supplies and items with a value of less than \$100 for use in their offices. The Board recommends that in all possible instances that these purchases be on a basis determined by the individual officer or department head to be competitive and impartial,

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and that such policy be set out in a memo to all county officers and department heads. Motion was seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.
