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- No application for an amendment, supplement, or change to the "Zoning (a) Regulations for Unincorporated Territory of Douglas County, Kansas", including the zoning map, conditional use permits, and Community Unit Plans, shall be accepted by the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission if an application for the same amendment, supplement, or change has been denied by the Board of County Commissioners within the preceding twelve (12) months. The withdrawal of an original application after it has been advertised for public hearing shall constitute a denial of the application just as if the public hearing had commenced and been concluded.
- (b) Irrespective of paragraph (a) above, an application for a rehearing may be accepted by the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission within twelve (12) months after a denial if it is accompanied by an affidavit setting forth facts which, in the judgement of the Planning Commission, constitute a substantial change from the original application tion. All requests for rehearing, as provided for in this section, shall be submitted to the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission fifteen (15) days prior to a regularly scheduled meeting of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission and shall be included on the agenda for that meeting as a non-public hearing item. If the Planning Commission determines that the application constitutes a substantial change from the original application, the item shall be advertised and a public hearing shall be held at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission.
