Approved the minutes of the meeting of November 1 and November 2, 1973.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 1146 and 1147. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 78 to the Sheriff, Clerk of District Court, and Treasurer.

The Board noted receipt of the rent payment for the months of October and November from Valleyview Care Home in the amount of \$500. Also received balance sheet as of September 30, 1973, and income statement for the period January 1, 1973, to September 30, 1973.

Mr. H. H. Belote, Civil Defense Director, received a check in the amount of \$26,459.60 from the State of Kansas. This amount is a reimburseable item from the State for the disaster warning system.

The Board approved a statement from Gelhaar Uniform Company in the amount of \$1326.50 for Douglas County Sheriff's Auxiliary and Douglas County Sheriff Department. This statement is to be paid from revenue sharing funds.
