It was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board accept the recommendation of Sheriff Johnson, Judge Elwell, and Chief Stanwix which was that we employ Dr. Lonnie Phillips as an Directo Douglas County Director of Court Services approximately February 1, 1974, as part-time, at a minimum salary of \$125 per month as suggested by Dr. Phillips, this salary to be reviewed in relation to a grant request to the Governor's Committee on Criminal Administration, which will be prepared by Dr. Phillips. Motion was seconded by Mr. Stoneback and carried unanimously.

> Dean Sanderson, Public Works Director, appeared before the Board with prepared Resolution No. 73-40 pertaining to the gross weight limit of three tons to be posted on the following bridges: 0.00N-0.03E, 0.00N-7.89E, 0.00N-8.82E, 0.00N-12.71E, and 0.00N-17.65E. These bridges are on the Franklin-Douglas County line. It was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board adopt this resolution, seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.

The Board noted receipt of concurrence of resolution relative to weight limits on the above mentioned bridges adopted by the Franklin County Commission.

The Board noted receipt of the minutes of the Lawrence-Douglas County Public Health Committee dated November 12, 1973.

Dean Sanderson, Public Works Director, appeared before the Board with prepared Resolution No. 73-41 relative to the gross weight limit of three tons to be posted on Bridge No. 05.74N-24.001E and 07.25N-24.00E, and gross weight limit of eight tons to be posted on Bridge No. 05.43N-24.00E. These bridges are on the Johnson-Douglas County line. It was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board adopt this resolution, seconded by Mr. Cragan and carried unanimously.

Mr. Gerald L. Cooley, attorney representing the City of Lawrence, appeared before the Board at 10:00 a.m. regarding the vacation of utility easement in and upon the following described real estate situated in Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, to-wit: The north five feet of the east 112.48 feet of Lot 41 and the south five feet of the east 112.48 feet of Lot 42, Country Club North, an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

Thereupon, the board examines the file, hears the comments of the attorney for the petitioner and being duly advised in the premises unanimously finds as follows, to-wit:

1. That the Board has jurisdiction of subject matter of said Petition, pursuant to K.S. A. 1972 Supp. 12-504 et. seq.

That notice of hearing on said Petition and the affidavit of publica-

tion thereof are examined and found to have been duly made in strict conformity with the laws of the State of Kansas.

3. That no private rights will be injured or endangered by such vacation.

4. That no written objection to said Petition has been filed with the County Clerk at the time of or prior to this hearing.

5. That the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience by said vacation, and that in justice to the petitioner the prayer of the petitioner should be and the same is hereby granted.

6. That there shall be reserved to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and all owners of lesser rights, for public utilities, rights-of-ways and easements for public service facilities, all such rights now in existence and use.

7. That the County Clerk shall certify a copy of this order to the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, for recording as provided by K.S.A. 1973 Supp. 12-505.

It was moved by Mr. Heck that the utility easement in and upon the aforementione real estate situated in Lawrence, Kansas, be vacated, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
