WHEREAS, on this 2nd day of January, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has met at regular session, the following Commissioners being present: Walter R. Cragan, Chairman; Arthur A. Heck, Member; and I. J. Stoneback, Member; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds pursuant to K.S.A. 28-816, 28-817, and 28-820, all as amended in 1973, that the presence of a state institution of higher education results in added duties for the County Attorney, the County Clerk, the County Treasurer, and the Sheriff of Douglas County, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds, pursuant to Chapter 175, Sections 6 and 7 of the 1973 Session Laws, that the existence of a military base in an adjacent county has resulted in added duties for the Clerk of the District Court of Douglas County and the Probate Judge, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds, pursuant to K.S.A. 28-818 as amended, that the existence of a Federal Reservoir in Douglas County has resulted in added duties for the Register of Deeds, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has, in the past, allowed additional compensation to the county officers as authorized and directed by statute,
