I wind your Bedding David Berkowitz, County Attorney, appeared before the Board to inform the Board that Mr. Michael Malone has returned from his three months leave of absence and is to be reinstated on a full time basis, with his salary at \$790 per month, effective February 1, 1974. Mr. Timothy Degginger, who has been replacing Mr. Malone while on leave of absence, will terminate his employment on February 1, 1974.

David Berkowitz, County Attorney, requested a one year length of service salary increase for Terri Lynn Redding. Mr. Berkowitz requested an increase of \$50 per month bringing the salary from \$425 per month to \$475 per month, effective February 1, 1974. It was moved by Mr. Stoneback that this request be granted, seconded by Mr. Heck, and carried unanimously.
