Micropiem! Contract signed how storage of micropiem weards

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The Board noted receipt of the returned signed contract from Underground Vaults and Storage, Inc., providing for storage of microfilm records of Douglas County consisting of 301 rolls of 35mm film and 342 rolls of 16mm film at an annual lease cost of \$336 (14 drawers) and an initial service charge of \$26.56.
