The Board considered surplus items which should be advertised for sale. - (3) One, Fairbanks-Morse, submersible pump, single phase, 230 volt, 15 hp (at Courthouse)

Berlunc Don Fickner A scheduled hearing was held relative to application for a cereal malt beverage license by Mr. Don Ticknor for the use of such license at an established location in Grant Township. Present for the hearing were the Grant Township Board, County Counselor Dan Young, Mr. Ticknor, and Counsel George Catt. The Grant Township governing board appeared to offer an advisory recommendation that for various reasons which they presented said license not be granted. Pertinent comment was then heard from Mr. Ticknor and his counsel relative to the merits of the proposed operation for which license was requested. Following other due comment from all concerned, it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that this cereal malt beverage license be issued, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
