County Attorney David Berkowitz appeared before the Board to request a two-year salary increase for second assistant County Attorney Mike Malone in the amount of \$55 per month, bringing his salary to \$900 per month, effective June 1, 1975. It was moved by Mr. Stoneback that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

County Attorney David Berkowitz presented the Board with a memo which consisted of an interim report on check prosecutions since the employment of a special investigator for this purpose. The memo indicated that considerable progress is being made in handling of check cases in conviction for violations of bad check laws and a considerable increase in restitution of bad checks.
