The Board considered the proposed county noxious weed budget for the calendar year 1976, which indicates the county's appropriation to that fund of \$32,430. It was moved by Mr. Stoneback that the Board tentatively approve this budget, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.
