crease in the noxious weed budget, which budget was adopted May 21, 1975. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Stoneback that we increase the noxious weed budget for the year 1976 by \$6,000, \$1,000 of which would be for rental spray equipment and \$5,000 for additional chemicals, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously. The Board requested Mr. Duver with the cooperation of Mr. Van Meter and Mr. Patton to present to the Board a procedural policy for noxious weed control especially musk thistle.

The Board received one bid for mowing prairie hay at Blackjack Park at Baldwin. That bid was submitted by Mr. Dana Cavender in the amount of \$5.25 per ton. It was moved by Mr. Whitenight that the bid of Mr. Cavender be accepted, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

The Board discussed with Sheriff Johnson continuing complaints being received concerning violation of closing hours at Wells Park. Following such discussion it was agreed by the Board that the regulations adopted by resolution concerning the operation of Wells Park will be enforced following properly posting of rules and regulations at the park, and that steps will be taken to close the entrance to Wells Park at times set out in the regulations.

Corner, Den, Goya: Boord of your and revised budgets Ernest Coleman presented the Board a revised budget for Community Development Application, Project No. B-75-DN-20-0011 for Douglas County, Kansas.
