Judge Mike Elwell appeared before the Board to request the employment of Martha Lawrence on a part-time temporary basis to serve as an assistant to probation officers in his department, at a wage rate of \$2.45 per hour, to be effective September 11, 1975. It was moved by Mr. Whitenight that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

Bob Duver, Noxious Weed Supervisor, appeared before the Board and presented the Board six quotes for the purchase of 500 gallons of 2,4-D as authorized by the Board on July 24, 1975.
