New-River Bridges, Representatives of the City of Lawrence, Mr. John Frazier of Finney & Turnipseed, consulting engineer, and Engineer Sanderson discussed with the Board bidding procedures relative to construction of two Kansas River bridges at Vermont and Massachusetts Streets. Following this discussion and indicated agreement, Engineer Sanderson presented the Board copy of notice to contractors on the proposed project. After due review it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that the Board approve this notice to contractors and establish the date of December 17, 1975, at 10:30 a.m. for the opening of bids for the project which will occur at the office of the County Commission, and with official publication dates being November 17 and December 1, 1975, seconded by Mr. Stoneback and carried unanimously.

The Board noted receipt of the minutes of the CSA meeting of November 10, 1975.

Tarkway as a County foremany artereal highEngineer Sanderson presented the Board prepared Resolution No. 75-42 which resolution designates Clinton Parkway as a County primary arterial highway extending easterly from Clinton Lake Access Road "A" approximately 4.1 miles to a junction at 23rd and Iowa Streets in the City of Lawrence under authority of Chapter 351 of the 1975 Session Laws of Kansas. Following review and due discussion of said resolution it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that the Board herewith adopt Resolution No. 75-42, and that this resolution be officially published and a copy transmitted to the City Clerk of Lawrence, seconded by Mr. Heck and carried. Mr. Heck and Mr. Whitenight voted "aye" on the motion. Mr. Stoneback being a landowner whose land would be involved in the Clinton Parkway right-of-way absented himself on this matter.

D'abdivisions; Engineer Sanderson presented to the Board a memorandum indicating that the Quin The Estate road in Quin T's Estates Subdivision has been inspected and found to be conwhice to completel, structed and hard surfaced in accordance with County standards thus completing the construction of streets in that subdivision. Engineer Sanderson recommended to the Board that this road be added to the Kanwaka Township Road Mileage and further recommended that the County offer Kanwaka Township an intergovernmental maintenance agreement for this hard surfaced road as set forth in Resolution No. 73-39. It was moved by Mr. Stoneback that the Board approve the recommendations of Engineer Sanderson, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

Cottonwood: prodification to Contract offerward

The Board approved the recommendation of Gary Condra, Cottonwood, Inc., for modification to Donation Contract No. 700-2 between the State Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services and the Douglas County Commissioners. The sections which formerly referred to Title IV-A and VI of the Social Security Act have been modified to refer to Title XX which became effective October 1, 1975.
