Order is on file in the office of the County Clerk. #1645 Jim Williams of the architectural firm of Peters, Williams & Kubota presented Courthouse opp. to the Board for its approval Change Order No. 1 on the contract with Norris additionmoney Brothers for site utilities on the remodeling of the Douglas County Courtto change site of power pole house project. This change order is for an added amount of \$368 for work required to change the location of the power pole on the north side of 11th Street based upon our notice of award which was dated 17 March 1977 and which indicated this additional change was to be for time and material not to exceed \$400. This additional amount of \$368 will bring the total contract sum to \$11,718. After review of this change order it was moved by Mr. Neis that this change order be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously. Mr. Williams presented an Application and Certificate for Payment on the Courthouse: app, Douglas County Courthouse remodeling project for the contract with Norris Pay Narris Bros. application #2 Brothers, Inc. on site utilities charges. This is application No. 2 and includes the period thru 31 March 1977. This application indicates the inclusion of Change Order No. 1 just previously passed upon which brings the total contract sum to \$11,718. This application indicates that the total completed to date is \$11,718, that no retainage is recommended, and that previous certificates for payment were for \$7,932 which leaves a current payment due on this project in the amount of \$3,786 which will be the final payment on this contract.
