> At the hour of 10:00 a.m. the Board conducted a public study session on Item No. 20 which was forwarded from the planning commission with their approval from their meeting on 27 April 1977. This item relates to a text amendment which would amend Article I, Section 104 (a) of Douglas County Resolution No 72-25, otherwise known as "Subdivision Regulations and Development Regulations for Douglas County, Kansas, and the City of Lawrence, Kansas," and also would amend Article VI, Section 603 of that same resolution. This study session was attended by a number of interested citizens, members of the plan ning commission, and planning staff. A lengthy discussion was held on this specific subject at hand and other broad range planning questions regarding residential development in the unincorporated territory of Douglas County. No firm decision was reached and the matter as presented from the planning commission will be further reviewed by this Board.

The Board met with Travis Brann, emergency preparedness coordinator, and requested that he arrange with the proposed contractor on the EOC communications package to have the subcontractor which is to develop the tower associated with the project to appear before the Board to discuss detailed plans and specifications and capabilities for that tower.
