Al Skeet, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to present quotes on a 3½ hp lawn mower with a rear mounted grass catcher. He presented four quotes of which the lowest was from Montgomery Ward & Company in the amount of \$148.95. After review of these quotes it was moved by Mr. Neis that the low quote be accepted, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

The Board discussed the hiring of an auctioneer to conduct the auction of surplus county property which is scheduled to be conducted on the 4th day of June 1977 at the Douglas County Fairgrounds. A number of options were reviewed and after full discussion on the matter it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board engage Leland Massey of Eudora to serve as auctioneer. Mr. Massey s fee will be at the rate of 10% of the total proceeds of the sale and he agrees to furnish both clerk and cashier. The county will absorb other promotional expenses involved. This motion was seconded by Mrs. Bradley and carried unanimously.

Ernest Coleman, federal funds consultant, appeared before the Board with a recommendation for employment for the director of the O'Connell Youth Ranch, Mr. Robert M. Davis who is a present employee of O'Connell Youth Ranch but who will be covered by the Douglas County sponsored GCCA grant which commenced as of May 1, 1977. The salary covered in this grant is \$900 per month. This amount will be paid from O'Connell Youth Ranch GCCA grant, the period which runs from 1 May 1977 to 30 April 1978. The specific title for Mr. Davis' position is O'Connell Youth Ranch teaching parent. After complete review of this recommendation it was moved by Mr. Neis that this hiring be ap-

proved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

The Board noted receipt of a check from the City of Lawrence, Kansas in the amount of \$2155 as partial reimbursement for Clinton Parkway engineering services.

The Board met with Travis Brann, emergency preparedness coordinator, to dis-Em. Prepared idioc, cuss the status of his department and its development. After a lengthy study session it was agreed by the Board that a study session would be requested Future between with the city staff and city commissioners to discuss the future development of an emergency preparedness philosophy and relationship for Douglas County City and Country and the City of Lawrence. It was further agreed that the Board would meet it company with Mr. Brann, those department heads within the county jurisdictio whose functions specifically deal with emergency preparedness problems to further develop a clear understanding of the functions of this department and how it relates to the other county departments. It is the hope that through these meetings will be developed a planning group which will work toward the redevelopment of the emergency operations plan for Douglas County and the City of Lawrence.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 1, 1977. Monday, May 30, 1977 is a legal holiday.
