Shepherd in the position of investigator in the county attorney's office with the effective date of employment to be 1 August 1977, at the suggested starting salary of \$900 per month to be paid from the county attorney personnel line item. After review of this recommendation and the qualifications of the individual involved, it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried.
