Tom McGee, engineering division manager, appeared before the Board and presented to the Board an application to the State Board of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, for a channel improvement at the proposed construction site of Douglas County Bridge No. 11.40N-19.00E located along or across Spring Creek. The purpose of this channel improvement as described is to improve the water course at this proposed county project site. It is noted that the adjacent property owners have reviewed this proposed change and recommend and endorse proposed improvements. After review of this application it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the application be approved and forwarded to the Division of Water Resources, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.

The agreement indicates that relocation of existing facilities which are currently located on private easement will be paid for by Douglas County and that those facilities within county right-of-way will be moved at utility company expense, and that the construction or alterations of the company's facilities shall be completed within 30 days after the county furnishes to the company the required information. After review of this agreement it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this utility agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried.
