REORDER NO. 126188-8-72 following described county road: Beginning at the center Quarter Corner of Section 10, Township 14 South, Range 18 East in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the center line of Federal Aid Secondary Route 1369; thence North on the center line of said Route approximately two (2) miles to the center Quarter Corner of Section 34, Township 13 South, Range 18 East. By this resolution the Board determined and declared the 50 miles per hour a reasonable and safe speed for the county road. This speed limit shall become effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon the county road above described. After review of the recommendation of Engineer Sanderson it was moved by Mr. Neis that this resolution be adopted, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.
