Administrative Judge Frank Gray appeared before the Board with Order No. 22 and 23 of the Seventh Judicial District of Kansas for the year 1977. Order implan No. 22 recommends to this Board the appointment of Jeanette Strippoli to req place Carol Ann Hess as half time secretary for Court Services effective 1 December 1977. It is pointed out that within this order Carol Ann Hess is 120mater; being transferred to Specialized Division C by another order. The administra-Carol anne Heas tive judge recommends half time salary for Ms. Strippoli of \$260 per month. to Sper, Dis. C After review it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously. Judge Gray then presented Order No. 23 of the Seventh Judicial District of Terminate: Kansas which order recommends that upon the joint recommendation of the Director of Court Services and the Chief Clerk and with the consent of the em-Linda Dichl ployee involved, Carol Ann Hess, the present half time secretary of Court Services be transferred to Specialized Division C as a full time deputy clerk beginning 1 December 1977 to replace Linda Diehl who has resigned effective 30 November 1977. The administrative judge recommends the salary of Carol Ann Hess to continue at the rate of \$596 per month. After review it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Brad ley, and carried unanimously. The Board considered an agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of Cottonwood. Douglas County and Cottonwood, Inc., a non-profit corporation, which agreement specifies that in accordance with provisions of K.S.A. 1977 Supp. 19-4004 aquement on contract through 19-4007 a tax has been levied to provide support for facilites for for 1778 services. the mentally retarded in Douglas County, Kansas, and that Cottonwood, Inc. has been established and approved by the State Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services as required by K.S.A. 1977 Supp. 19-4007. This contract is for the period commencing 1 January 1978 and terminates 31 December 1978, and agrees to pay to the contractor, Cottonwood, Inc., the sum of \$54,000. In consideration of the payment of this sum the contractor, Cottonwood, Inc., shall furnish and render the services for the mentally retarded as set forth in K.S.A. 19-4001 et seq. After complete review of this agreement and all of
