Ernest Coleman, federal funds consultant, appeared before the Board to request the Board's concurrence in the submission of an application for a continuation of Subgrant No. 76-A3094-4-A known as the O'Connell Youth Ranch Project. The application is submitted to the Governor's Committee on Criminal Administration. The total amount of this application is \$35,060. The amount to be paid by GCCA is \$26,160, if approved, the State's contribution will be \$700, and the
