The Board made note of correspondence from Lewis C. Carter, Clerk of The Supreme Court of Kansas, which gives notice that the terms of office for two non-lawyer members to the District Judicial Nominating Commission for the Seventh Judicial District will expire on the first Monday in March 1978, namely, Corlett Cotton of Lawrence, Kansas, and Don Nutt of Baldwin, Kansas. The notice indicates that the persons presently serving may be reappointed to the term of four years.
