The Board reviewed a notice to Douglas County from the State Department of Paul Works' Transportation, Mr. W. M. Lackey, District Engineer. This notice refers to St. Dept. Turns Project No. (BC)10-23-RF-DP 078-6 (23) referring to the State Highway Commission resolution dated 8 May 1974. This notice indicates that maintenance old K-10 overto on the following described sections of presently traveled K-10 becomes the County responsibility of Douglas County commencing at 1:30 p.m. on 18 January 1978. The area described is as follows: Beginning on the present traveled way of K-10 at the interchange of new K-10, one mile east of Eudora; thence east on the present traveled way of K-10 to the Douglas-Johnson County Line. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Nois that the notice to the County be executed by the County Commission and forwarded to the district engineer, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously. It is understood that the full length of cold K-10 in Douglas County is now subject to County maintenance. The Board discussed at length a request from Sheriff Johnson that an allow-Sheriff's Depl. 1 app. ance be provided to the officers in the Sheriff's Department for uniform Spermonth allowour footwear. After the discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that an allowance of \$5 per month be added to the current uniform cleaning allowance to be for footwear used for the purchase of uniform footwear for the employees of the Sheriff's Department which purchases are intended to be made subject to the approval of the Sheriff or Undersheriff. This motion seconded by Mr. Neis and carried unanimously. At the advertised hour of 1:30 p.m., the Board received bids for General Contract No. 3 on the Remodeling Project of the Douglas County Courthouse. One Consthance! bid was received, that being from B.A. Green Construction Company in the a-Gen Contract #3 mount of \$208,300. It was indicated in the bid that 200 calendar days were needed to complete the contract and that Alternate No. 1 showed a deduction allowance of \$10,420. After a brief review of the bid documents it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that they be taken under advisement by the architects Peters, Williams & Kubota for their review and recommendation, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. The firm of Peters, Williams & Kubota was represented at this bid opening by Jim Williams and Stan Harris. The Board received correspondence from Ivan F. Shull which indicates that he esignation ! is submitting his resignation from the Douglas County Advocacy Council on Aging effective 25 January 1978. The Board agreed to accept this resignation with regrets. Darwin Rogers, county appraiser, appeared before the Board to recommend that the Board set dates for the periods during which they will sit as a Board of Dates set for Board of Equalization 1978 Equalization for the year 1978. It is recommended that the Board will sit for the purpose of inquiring into the valuation of real property beginning on Monday, April 3 through the month and for the purpose of inquiring into the valuation of personal property commencing on the 1st day of May 1978 and continuing through the month. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the Board direct County Clerk Delbert Mathia to publish these dates dur ing which the Board will sit as a Board of Equalization in the newspaper of record for Douglas County on 9, 16, and 23 February, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
