The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present. Due to inclement weather no meeting was held on Monday, February 13, 1978.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 1748. Order is on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board noted receipt of copy of minutes and reports from the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department for the month of December 1977.

The Board approved monthly fee reports for the following county offices: Sheriff, County Clerk, Public Works Department, Register of Deeds, and the Seventh Judicial District of Kansas.

Valleyview app, Purchase of port. aspirator Kathy Smith, Valleyview Administrator, appeared before the Board to recommend the purchase of an Accucare, Model MDS 80-2200, portable lightweight aspirator, manufactured by Medline Industries, Inc. The low quote on this piece of equipment is \$138.55 which is the low quote amongst eight quotes received for this or similar equipment. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this quote be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Jim Williams, of the firm Peters, Williams & Kubota, presented the Board for its consideration the contractual agreement between the owner and contractor on General Contract No. 3 on the remodeling project of the Douglas County Courthouse. This contract is in the amount of \$208,300 in accordance with the terms of the bid which was accepted by this Board on February 6, 1978. The contract is executed by Robert J. Green, President of the B. A. Green Construction Company. After review of the contract it was moved by Mr. Neis that it be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Relocate Grand two road in area of Cirport between City and Country The Board noted receipt of a letter from City Manager Buford Watson, of the City of Lawrence, relating to an agreement between Douglas County and the City of Lawrence on the relocation of a Grant township road in the area of the Lawrence Airport. The letter indicates that it is the intent of the City Commission to pay for the excavation and fill necessary for the road. The right-of-way which is in addition to the levee right-of-way will be purchased by the City. The engineering for the project will be paid by the City. It is understood that Douglas County will finish grade the excavated material and will furnish and place the rock on the road. It is agreed by the Board that this letter of agreement is in substantial conformance with our understanding between the County and the City of Lawrence on this project and is accepted.

At the advertised hour of 10:00 a.m. public hearing was held on the matter of a Petition to Release Lands from Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, Douglas County, Kansas, and Petition to Attach Lands to Douglas County Rural Water District No. 3, Douglas County, Kansas. The petitioners appear by their attorneys Stumbo, Stumbo, Palmer, McCallister & Buening of Topeka, Kansas. There are no other appearances, either in person or by counsel. Regarding the Petition to Release Lands from Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, the Board makes the following findings:

- (1) That the allegations of said Petition are true; that the lands as described in said Petition, are currently included in Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, Douglas County, Kansas, and cannot be economically or adequately served by the facilities of the District.
- (2) That it would be in the best interests of the petitioning landowners and Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, Douglas County, Kansas, if said lands involved and described in said Petition are released and separated from the District.

Therefore in accordance with the terms of K.S.A. 82a-630, it is hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that said Petition be granted and the lands described are hereby released and separated from Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, Douglas County, Kansas, and it is further ordered by this Board that a Certificate of Release in accordance with the terms of the statute be forthwith issued by this Board and delivered to the Secretary of the Water District who shall, within thirty days, cause the records of the Water District to exclude the lands described therein. After review of this order it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that it be adopted, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

In accordance with the terms of this order and based upon the petition here-tofore filed with the clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, to have certain lands released and separated from Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, Douglas County, Kansas, the Board considered the adoption of Certificate of Release of Certain Lands from Douglas County Rural Water District No. 1, Douglas County, Kansas.
