Mr. Coleman then presented the Board, Douglas County Revenue Sharing Contract for the 1978 allocation to Douglas County Youth Jobs in the amount of \$14,000. The contract is executed for Douglas County Youth Jobs by Martha Jean O'Toole and after review it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this contract be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Along with this revenue sharing contract is a contract for hire for the job and accounting coordinator for the Douglas County Youth Jobs project. This contract is between Martha Jean O'Toole, the coordinator, and Ernest J. Coleman, federal funds consultant. The contract indicates the duties of this coordinator and specifies a compensation of \$1250 for eleven weeks of coordination services and related clerical work which shall be paid as follows in three equal payments: the first about July 1, the second about August 1, and the third after the final report has been completed. Mr. Coleman presented this contract for the Board's consideration and approval and after review it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that it be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
