The duration of this grant, if approved, will be from 1 July 1978 to 30 June 1979 and the application projects a net cost of \$13,724 with a contribution from the federal government thru GCCA in the amount of \$4,050.01, the state contribution will be \$225, with the contribution to be made by Douglas County in the amount of \$9,448.99. After complete discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this grant application be approved for submission to GCCA, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Delbert Mathia, county clerk, appeared before the Board to request the purchase of an IBM selectric typewriter, 154" carriage, serial No. 3689332, at a cost of \$702, to be funded by direct election fund. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this request be granted, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Ernest Coleman, federal funds consultant, appeared before the Board to recommend the approval of two grant applications which are to be forwarded to GCCA Unant application for their consideration and potential approval. The first of these is a O'Connell Youth grant application entitled "O'Connell Youth Ranch - Career Training Equipme for Youth Programs" with the period of the grant to run from 1 July 1978 to Ranch for support 30 June 1979. The total amount of the application is \$9,960, with the fed-eral contribution by GCCA to be \$2.064 grant application entitled "O'Connell Youth Ranch - Career Training Equipment eral contribution by GCCA to be \$8,964, the state contribution to be \$498, and the applicant contribution to be \$498. It is pointed out at this time that Douglas County serves only as a financial agent and the application will be generated through local community funding.
