pensation at the rate of \$10 per day for those days when they are on an "on call" status. After review of these recommendations it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that they be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. McFarlane then makes the following recommendations:

(1) That the \$10 per day fee for those individuals on an "on call" status be effective as of 1 January 1978.

(2) That within these new wage scale and classification ranges, the following adjustments be made based on merit, length of service, and change of classification to be made effective 1 March 1978:

Gary Sharp, shift supervisor, from the current rate of \$995 per month to a new rate of \$1120 per month.

Deedra Sturgeon, shift supervisor, from the current rate of \$971 per month to a new rate of \$1060 per month.

Roger Lee, shift supervisor, from the current rate of \$971 to \$1110 per month.

Duane Filkins, EMIC-T, from the current rate of \$971 per month to a new rate of \$1080 per month.

James Murray, EMIC-T, from the current rate of \$971 per month to a new rate of \$1050 per month.

Mr. McFarlane points out that all of the above employees except Ms. Sturgeon fall within the two to five year bracket. Ms. Sturgeon falls within the one to two year bracket. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that these recommendations be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

water irrigation
line in Dg. Co. by
Arden Ott*

Tom McGee, engineering division manager, appeared before the Board to present an application for authority to construct water irrigation line in Douglas County applied for by Arden Ott. The application requests permission to lay said water irrigation line on the surface of the ground across the right-of-way for Douglas County FAS Route 2101 at a point approximately 590 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 6, Township 13, Range 21 in Douglas County, Kansas, and running Southwesterly under the Wakarusa River Bridge on said road as shown on the plan attached to the application. Within this application the applicant agrees to a number of stipulations and limitations with regard to the eventual approval of this application. After full consideration of the application the Board reviewed a resolution granting Arden Ott permission to construct the 8 inch aluminum irrigation line as requested in said application. Mr. Neis moved that permission to construct as applied for be granted to the applicant, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

bury plastic telephone
line*

Mr. McGee then presented an application from Continental Telephone of Kansas in Douglas County requesting authority to construct buried plastic telephone line in said county. The request is to allow the applicant to lay its 6 and 12 pair line within a plastic buried line in said county and state. The application indicates that the applicant desires to lay said telephone line as shown on the plan attached to the application in accordance with the requirements of Douglas County at a point approximately 65 feet south of the Northwest corner of Section 9, Township 15, Range 21, in Douglas County. After discussion the Board reviewed a resolution granting Continental Telephone of Kansas authority to construct buried plastic telephone line in accordance with the terms of the application form. It was moved by Mr. Neis that this resolution be adopted and granted as requested, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 8, 1978.
