Reo. 78-9; Donald Gordon oppointed Co. appraiser

The Board considered Resolution No. 78-9 which indicates that whereas Darwin Rogers, duly appointed County Appraiser who was appointed on January 6, 1977, for a four-year term pursuant to K.S.A. 19-430 et seq, has retired effective March 1, 1978 and thereby created a vacancy in the position of County Appraiser, and whereas, Donald E. Gordon is qualified under the provisions of K.S.A. 19-430 to be appointed Douglas County Appraiser. It is therefore by this document unanimously resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that Donald E. Gordon be appointed County Appraiser of Douglas County, Kansas, to serve the unexpired portion of the four-year term ending June 30, 1981, and beyond that until his successor is appointed. Pursuant to K.S.A. 19-434, Donald E. Gordon shall receive an annual salary in the amount of \$17,500.00. Having fully considered this Resolution No. 78-9 it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that resolution appointing Mr. Donald E. Gordon as County Appraiser of Douglas County, Kansas, be adopted, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of March 15, 1978.

The Board reviewed a recommendation from Nancy Lignitz, Director of Volunteers Oprothyloguer Judicial District. In this correspondence Ms. Lignitz recommends a six-month increase based on merit for Dorothy Roeyer, Assistant Director of Volunteers in Court, of 6%. Ms. Roeyer's present salary of \$433 per month would raise to \$459 per month with this increase effective 1 March 1978. This recommendation is forwarded to this Board from Judge Paddock with a recommendation for acceptance. This rate is determined as derived from his current annual salary and shall continue on a part-time basis until such time as the new appraiser begins work for Douglas County. This motion seconded by Mr. Neis and carried unanimously.
