Having met with County Weed Supervisor Bob Duver and Byron Patton, State Board of Agriculture, on the question of the Douglas County Noxious Weed Department budget for January 1, 1979 to December 31, 1979, it was agreed by the Board that the following budget be adopted: A total expenditure projected in the amount of \$78,420 for chemical, personnel, and equipment; total reimbursements in the amount of \$22,700; and with county levy appropriations in the amount of \$55,720 which provides a total receipt figure in the amount of \$78,420. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this budget be adopted, including county appropriations to the purpose in the amount of \$55,720, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried.

Don Gordon, Douglas County Appraiser, presented to the Board the 1978 increase in assessed values for real estate in Douglas County for land and improvements broken down by townships and cities.
