The Board reviewed a special request for revenue sharing funds which has been Rev. Shar. app. filed with this Board by the Douglas County Rape Victim Support Service. The total amount requested is \$1465.50 which will be used to provide minimum salaries, office supplies, social security, telephone, copying, and rent for their facilities during that time.
