It is clearly understood that the applicant contribution, in this year, and in future years is not intended to be drawn from Douglas County levy funds or revenue sharing funds but that Douglas County's role in this grant application is purely as sponsor and fiscal agent. The application is for the period 1 October 1978 to 30 September 1979. After a complete review of this application and discussion on Douglas County's role in relationship to it, it was moved by Mr. Neis that we sign the application as an official unit of government authorized to sign and forward to GCCA for their review and potential approval. Motion seconded by Mr. Whitenight and carried.

Supplemental funds
for Rape Service

The Board reviewed a special request for revenue sharing funds which has been filed with this Board by the Douglas County Rape Victim Support Service. Funds will be used to supplement their operation from 1 June 1978 to 31 December 1978. The total amount requested is \$1465.50 which will be used to provide minimum salaries, office supplies, social security, telephone, copying, and rent for their facilities during that time. After discussion on this proposal for a special allocation, it was moved by Mr. Neis that the allocation be approved in the amount of \$1465.50 from revenue sharing funds. This motion seconded by Mr. Whitenight and carried.

The Board noted receipt of communication from Kansas State Board of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, granting approval of plans relating to proposed channel change along West Taub Creek, at a location in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 19 East, Douglas County, Kansas, for Bridge No. 03.80N-12.05E. The approved permit has been remitted to the public works department for their file.

Change order for
Project #23 RS 508(9)
Grading

The Board noted receipt of correspondence from Robert A. Cook, P.E., Resident Engineer of the Kansas Department of Transportation with regard to Project No. 23 RS 508 (9) Grading. This correspondence forwards to this Board a proposed change order on the above referenced project which recommends an increase of 58 linear feet of 24" erosion pipe, an increase of 1.8 cubic yards Class A concrete, and an increase of 90 pounds of reinforcing steel. This change is recommended based on some problems of drainage which have been developed in the course of this project. It is recommended by Mr. Cook that the Board agree to this change which is in the net amount of \$2,000.20. This additional amount will be subject to the same ratio of federal and local funding as exists on the balance of the project. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this proposed change be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried.


No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, June 19, 1978.

Douglas County Clerk Delbert Mathia reported a change in the employees serving as voter registration clerks.
