Sheriff Johnson recommends that Charles Rumsey, dis-Sal, Dar, patcher, be granted a one-year increase based upon merit of approximately 6% from \$714 per month to \$755 per month effective 1 July 1978, and Linda Collins, Betly Moore dispatcher, be granted a one-year increase based upon merit of approximately 6% from \$714 per month to \$755 per month, effective 1 July 1978.
