The agreement indicates that relocation of existing 13-R5-1347(7) R/W facilities which are currently located on private easement will be paid for by Douglas County and that those facilities within county right-of-way will be moved at utility company expense, and that the construction or alterations of the company's facilities shall be completed within ninety days after the county furnishes to the company the required information. After review of this agreement it was moved by Mr. Neis that this utility agreement be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously. The Board reviewed joint Douglas County Resolution No. 78-21 and City of Law-Rec #178-21 : review rence Ordinance No. 4945 which is a joint resolution and ordinance regarding Sub. road platting the platting of County roads in a subdivision in which all lots are three acres or greater and the development of such roads in accordance with the Douglas County road standards and, in addition, an amendment to the subdivision regulations (Chapter 20, Article 1A, Section 42 (28), of the City of Lawrence and Section 901(28) of Douglas County, Kansas). After review of the language of this joint resolution it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that it be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. This joint resolution shall be in full force and effect subsequent to its passage and publication as provided by law. The Board noted receipt of minutes and reports from the Lawrence-Douglas County Public Health Department for the month of May 1978.

Sue Neustifter, Register of Deeds, notified the Board that Audrey B. Garber will terminate on July 14, 1978.

The Board reviewed a correspondence received from Donna J. Kidd, Area Director of the Jayhawk Area Agency on Aging, which is requesting the amount of \$3,200 to be paid as a share of the administrative costs for the operation of that agency and to provide matching funds for the year 1978-79. In addition, it is pointed out in the correspondence of Jayhawk Area Agency on Aging that the 1977 contribution from Douglas County in the amount of \$3,000 has not been remitted. After review and discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that both payments be made in the total amount of \$6,200 in support of the operation of this agency, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. This amount is to be paid from the commissioners matching fund line item.

The Board reviewed the requests brought before it by various agencies which had requested an allocation of revenue sharing funds for the year 1979. After a complete review of all of these requests, and having met with the City of Lawrence to determine our mutual obligations for funding such organizations, it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the following allocations be made
