Tom McGee, engineering division manager, appeared before the Board to present a contract for the purchase of highway right-of-way on Project No. FAS 23-RS-1347(7) between Elmer J. This contract provides for a lump sum payment of \$450 for 0.03 acres of right-of-way, 0.33 acres temporary easement for construction, 10 rods barb fence, 17 rods temporary fence, and includes allowance for irregularity of fencing, some good trees, and abstracting.
